For submission of abstract/paper to the congress follow the instructions below.

Abstracts and Papers Submission

The abstracts and/or the extended papers will be sent to the e-mail address: plantasmedfmvz@yahoo.com as an attached document. Please, entitle the attached document and the “subject” of the message with the last name of the first author.

The Scientific Committee will make the selection of the abstracts and/or papers, and it will notify the authors before July 23rd, 2004. All abstracts or papers accepted by the Scientific Committee will be published in the Book of Memories of the Congress (ISBN in process).

Last date for abstracts and/or papers submission: June 30, 2004.

Abstracts Submission:

- The abstract will be in letter size pages (8.5 x 11”), single space between rows, font Times New Roman (12) in Word 6.0 (Microsoft) or superior. All english presentations will be considered to participate in the poster session, check specific indication for poster characteristics.
- The title of the work should appear first, centered, in bold, capital letters. Names of authors will be two spaces below in bold letters, with initials of the first name, followed by the last names and separated by comas. The institutions identification should appear one space below the authors name, please indicate the name of the institution, postal address, city and country. We recommend to include phone and fax number, as well as e-mail address or other important information.
- The text of the abstract should begin two spaces below the institutions identification, without special marks or additional spaces between paragraphs. The text will not include photos. Figures, tables and formulas are accepted. Scientific names of plants or animals should be in italic letters.
- Abstracts should not excede one page of size, it’s recommended to organize the abstract with the following structure: problem identification, work hypothesis, materials and methods used, results and importance.
- Include some actualized bibliographic references (no more than three).
- At the moment of sending the abstract or main paper, please fill the registration form. English speaking authors who want to submit their works although they cannot assure physical participation are not supposed to pay for registration.

Extended Paper Submission:

Extended papers will have a maximum of five pages long (letter size -8,5 x 11-, printed on one side only), one space between typed lines and with te following structure: Abstract, Introduction (brief, it should include the objectives), materials and methods, results and discussion, conclusions and bibliographic references (no more than ten). The text should be written in Times New Roman font, size 12, with Word 6.0 system (Microsoft) and with the following specifications:

- The format of the title, authors, institutions identification and country must be the one suggested in “Abstracts Submission” .
- Images, tables and/or graphics should form part of the Word document, and should not be bigger than 300 Kbytes.

POSTER SESSION

The Organizer Committee will look for local funding so that at least ten posters of foreigner authors can be printed. The author should submit by e-mail the abstract and/or the extended work as well as the structure and diagram of the poster. The basic format should not be greater than 82 (horizontal) and 120 centimeters (vertical). The title will be the same as the submitted in the abstract or main paper. We recommend the following organization: Abstract, Introduction, Materials and Methods, Results and Discussion, Conclusions, Bibliographic References and Acknowledgements.
